Little Dilly Practice Round is June 26th, 2024

Due to this year's popularity in the Little Dilly Tournament the Practice round on June 26th will be limited to Dilly Participants only. Normal Men's Day play will not be allowed on that day.

Sign-up for the Practice Round will open on May 15th, so please call the pro shop to schedule your tee times. We will be allowing 4-somes and 6-somes on the practice round, however 5-somes will not be allowed due to open cart seats.

Sign-up for the Par 3 Challenge for the Little Dilly will go live at **9 AM May 20th**. This will be via Golf Genius. There will be a maximum of 54 teams this year and with the additional teams we anticipate it will fill up quickly. There will be a waitlist, so we recommend signing up for a chance to play in case some teams drop out. Entry fees are \$100 per team and you are not required to play with your Dilly partner but both players do have to be participating in the Little Dilly Tournament. The entry fees are due to the pro shop and will be <u>cash only</u> and payment is due no later than June 21st.

MOTHER'S DAY – Sunday, May 12

This year we are offering both a limited brunch menu and a limited dinner menu for Mother's Day. Reservations are required so please call 307-235-5777 x1.

Brunch: served 9am – 2 pm

All come with choice of potato (except French Toast) Lobster Benedict – poached lobster with roasted reb pepper hollandaise and a poached egg served on a grilled English muffin.

Crab Cake Benedict – with grilled asparagus, potato croquette, a poached egg and avocado hollandaise.

Green Goddess Omelete – with asparagus, heirloom tomato, gruyere cheese and green goddess sauce.

Filet Mignon Omelete – grilled filet with wild mushrooms, onion, tomato and gouda cheese with house made hollandaise.

Chicken Fried Ribeye – tenderized ribeye in cracker meal breading and fried crisp then topped with our jalapeno sausage gravy.

Biscuit & Gravy – house made cheddar chive biscuit with jalapeno sausage gravy.

Lemon Ricotta Stuffed French Toast – with lemon icing, whipped cream and a berry compote.

Dinner: served 4pm – 8 pm

Appetizers:

Crab Cake – baked jumbo lump crab cake with lemon butter sauce **Avocado Toast** – buttery brioche toast with avocado, smoked salmon, a sherry reduction and micro herbs.

Entrees:

Tournedos Rossini – pan-seared filet mignon with garlic Dijon brioche crostini, whipped potato and a truffle madeira wine sauce. Served with roasted Brussel sprouts.

Butter Poached Lobster Tail – cold water lobster tail slow poached to perfection in white wine butter, served with asparagus, hollandaise sauce and potato croquette.

Patagonian Shrimp – grilled pink Patagonian shrimp with asparagus risotto and a roasted red pepper beurre blanc.

Airline Chicken Breast – with wild mushroom ravioli in a red wine reduction sauce and prosciutto wrapped asparagus.

With the warm weather we've recently had, our team has been weeding out and smoothing sand in the bunkers. This has been our main focus after a very dry windy winter. Irrigation has been running smoothly and we have been tweaking and adjusting heads. We have mowed greens several times at a higher height of cut. We will start slowly lowering the cut and be at our summer cutting height by the middle to late May. Fairways have been mowed and we have started to mow rough as well. With warmer temps ahead we will get into a frequent mowing schedule.

We also have some projects going on. We will be building a new retaining wall on #8 teebox. I think this will give that area a great new look. The parking lot is almost wrapped up, we reshaped a small area and will be finishing it with river rock. I have also been working on shaping a no-mow area right of 17 green. I plan to seed this with a native grass mix that should come in nicely.
