#### **Club History**



We are getting back into the summer routine and greens have been lowered down to their summer height. We will verticut and topdress them with sand on June 3<sup>rd</sup>, this will increase smoothness and green speeds overall.



Remember to sign your youngster up for Junior Golf. The 1<sup>st</sup> Junior Camp starts Monday, June 17<sup>th</sup>. If you haven't registered, please do so in the golf shop.

For CCC to provide an exceptional golf experience to all of its members, the board of directors has spent many years developing policies that are expected to be followed by its members and employees. (These rules can be found on the club's website.) As we get into the summer, I must remind the membership of some of these rules.

- 1) A player must have a valid driver's license to drive a cart.
- 2) Members under the age of 15 years old are not permitted to play the golf course before 11 AM on the Weekends. (They may accompany players but are not allowed to play.)
- 3) Private Golf Carts must be registered with the Golf Shop. (Please don't forget to give Todd or Brad your Carts Insurance and also to pick up your registration sticker.)
- 4) A Private Golf Cart trail fee covers the family membership. Any player riding a private cart that is not part of the family membership will be responsible for the regular cart fee.
