**How do I log onto my account?** Most of the billing statements will have your PIN printed at the bottom of the page. If not, please call the office and Alena will set it up. Your account number is your member number.

**How long do I have to pay my bill?** Payments are due by the last day of the month. We can also set up auto pay via ACH or credit card.

**What is my food minimum cycle?** If your last name is in the first half of the alphabet (A-L) your minimum covers the calendar month. If your last name is M-Z your minimum goes from the 16<sup>th</sup> to the 15<sup>th</sup> of the next month.
